The new VFW Post, to be known as Post 10523, was officially chartered October 12, 1988, in the then-village of Canal Winchester. It is now — at the "30-Year Mile-Marker" — A top (All-State) VFW Post in the entire state of Ohio!!

The new post got off to a good start and with several (normal) "down times" has done very well over the 30 years. THAT EARLY "NEW VFW POST" HAS BLOSSOMED INTO A TOP VFW POST IN THE STATE — ALL-STATE RATINGS NEARLY EVERY YEAR!
