One minor problem that was discovered was with our post liability insurance not having the state and national VFW listed as an endorsement - and we updated our policy to reflect the change. We will be having a Veterans Day ceremony in Canal Winchester as in years past, but it will be modified due to the Covid-19 pandemic. There will be no breakfast as in years past, and we will assemble at the train depot at the corner of North High Street and West Oak Street at 9:30am. At around 10:00am, we will start the march, going south on high street to Columbus Street and turn right, and then make another right behind the Insurance Circle onto Warehouse Alley. We'll end at the Stradley greenspace area where a 40 foot by 40 foot tent will be set up for our ceremony.

The ceremony will be Saturday, November 7th just after the march, starting at about 10:30am. Our guest speaker will be our fellow comrade, Pat Durbin. As in years past, we will need shooters, flag bearers and most important, fellow veterans to participate in the march. Bob Taylor will be calling for help, so please step up. As with all the concerns with the Covid-19 restrictions, this march will be a challenge this year. Motts' Military Museum will have their vehicles participating so that those who want to ride will be able. We will need to make certain we have face mask and use social distancing as possible. If you have any questions, please call me. Hope for good weather! I will close for now so I hope to see as many of you for

our Veterans Day ceremony as possible. "Veterans in Action - Because we Care."
