American Legion Riders and other members of the American Legion Family brought back over 1 million dollars in their Legacy run in Aug covering 1400 miles in 4 states. They have more than 12.6 million since 2006. The money is used by the American Legion Legacy Scholarship Fund to provide college scholarships to children of post 9/11 veterans who died on active duty or veterans with a combined VA disability of 50% or more.
